The Future of Urban Transport: Making Public Transport more Individual and Individual Transport more Public

"SciNet - young ÖVG" is the organisation of young academics and researchers within the Austrian Society for Traffic and Transport Science (ÖVG). It is open to scientists up to 40 years of age at universities, public or private research institutions and companies or organisations. The promotion of transport research - and of young researchers - is the main objective of "SciNet" and the entire ÖVG.

For academic advances and qualifications, presentations at scholarly conferences and papers published in high quality journals are increasingly required. Therefore, "SciNet" aims at providing such opportunities to disseminate research results, accordingly. In order to ensure scientific standards submissions will be reviewed by a programme committee.

Researchers from all transport related disciplines (transport engineering, economics, law, psychology, etc.) who conduct method-based research in the above mentioned field are invited to submit an **extended abstract** and in the following a **full paper** relevant to the topic of the conference. Abstract and paper should be in English. The extended abstract should comprise a maximum of 750 words, the full paper 7.000 words. Authors also need to provide a short CV of up to one page including full contact details and their affiliation (particularly institution, email address and phone number).

The willingness to **present the paper in person at the conference is a prerequisite for submission**. For presenters, the participation fee will be waived; one accompanying person can participate at a reduced rate. However, travelling expenses will not be covered.

Abstracts need to be submitted until **June 30th, 2014**. Authors will be notified about **acceptance** before **August 31st, 2014**. Full papers **need to be received by November 1st, 2014**. The conference takes place on **November 28th, 2014 in Vienna**. Papers will be published in the Austrian Journal of Transport Sciences (Österreichische Zeitschrift für Verkehrswissenschaft; ÖZV) or in another adequate form.
