Volos is one of the largest and most attractive cities in Greece as well as one of the country's most prominent ports, located on the Pagasetic Gulf, where it is believed that the Argonautica started, as narrated by Homer. It is the capital of the area known as Magnesia, which includes the Pelion mountain (and homonymous peninsula), known from the Greek Mythology as the Centaurs' and muses' kingdom and the motherland of Jason. Volos is situated in the centre of Greece, about 320 km north of Athens and 220 km south of Thessaloniki and combines the allure of the blue sea with the mystical charm of the green mountain.
