Purpose: The purpose of the Urban Street Symposium is to stimulate improvements in suburban/urban street design practices. It will provide a forum to:

- Compare and discuss alternative street design practices.
- Document better street designs.
- Transfer urban street research findings to state agencies and to local governments.

The topic of your abstract is to be related to urban street design research or practice, which may include but is not limited to the following topics.

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The Symposium **presentation modes** include:

- Poster: Show your **project** or **concept** with pictures, a model, or computer graphics.
- Podium: Write and present a paper, based on a concept or project. Note that some papers will be selected for poster sessions.

Submit abstracts by 31 October 2016 as PDF document.

- ▶ Each submitted abstract must be in English, must fit on one page, and must include:
 - Abstract: the abstract is to not exceed 250 words.
 - Contact: provide name, address, phone number, and email for corresponding author.
 - Topic: provide the general topic of the abstract (example: "Transit Facilities").
 - Source: indicate whether this abstract is based on a project -- or -- research topic.Also, if your presentation is suitable **only** as a "poster", then please indicate this.

- ▶ Name your abstract file as follows: 2017 USS5 Surname - one or two words describing the topic (example: "2017 USS5 Smith - transit facilities")
