***The Final CycleCities Project meeting, in Piraeus, from 11th-13th of November 2014, will include the following:***

The 7th Interregional Forum (11/11/2014)  
The 3<sup>rd</sup> and Final International Conference (12/11/2014)  
The 8<sup>th</sup> interregional workshop (13/11/2014)

**On the 11th**, CycleCities partners and participants will focus on how cycling is key for the successful development and regeneration of port-cities identifying how the good practices gathered by the project could be put into practice. Under the guidance of an expert from the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), partners Piraeus, Genoa, London, Lisbon and Gdansk will present their city cases followed by a round table discussion on developing a framework for promoting cycling in relation to tourism and cruise shipping development. The audience will include representatives from hellenic and foreign stakeholders who we hope will be interested by the ideas generated from the project.

**On the 12th**, during the Final Conference all of the project outcomes will be presented and under 3 categories:

1. Partners plans for Cycling and sustainable planning. The conference will show how the knowledge and experiences gained from the project will be utilized in the interventions, measures and policies so they can aim to become an optimum Cycle City. The plans will include how developing and progressing cycling networks are fundamental to ensuring people friendly cities.
2. A presentation of 4 Good practice guides covering the best Europe has to offer in respect to:
  - Land Use Planning related to cycling,
  - Mobility Management strategies & approaches for cycling in Europe,
  - Participation strategies of administrations for reshaping urban mobility; and
  - Architectural Design of Cycling Infrastructure. Conference will feature some specific good practice cases and the related guidelines to ensure the quality.
3. Public and Private investments on cycling and examples of how they can help deliver environmental & economic benefits essential to a sustainable future.

The Final Conference will be co-organised by the Hellenic Institute of Transportation Engineers, who will promote and share at the end of the day, a few key issues on cycling planning, solutions and limitations and also big cycling projects in Attica Region in Greece.

**On the 13<sup>th</sup>**, the final interregional workshop will feature a demonstration of a new model for the Cost Benefit Analysis of Cycling Investments developed alongside the CycleCities project using examples from the project partners' cities.

Finally the last project partnership steering group will be held Where after three years we have to say goodbye to our partners that have also become friends with the hope that we can add "...see you soon."
